

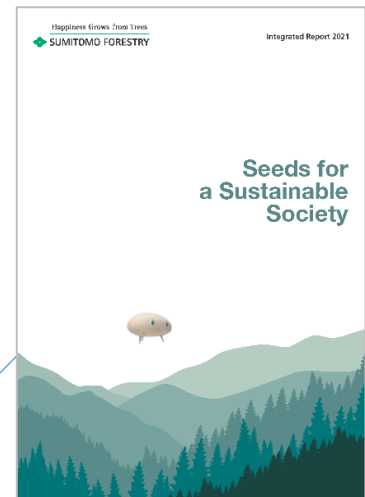
Release of Integrated Report 2021
