Sumitomo Forestry Co., Ltd. (President and Representative Director: Toshiro Mitsuyoshi; headquarters: Tokyo; hereinafter, Sumitomo Forestry) is pleased to announce on July 23rd, it has released on its website the English translation of *The Sustainability Report 2026*, a summary of Sumitomo Forestry Group's initiatives to contribute to a sustainable and prosperous society.

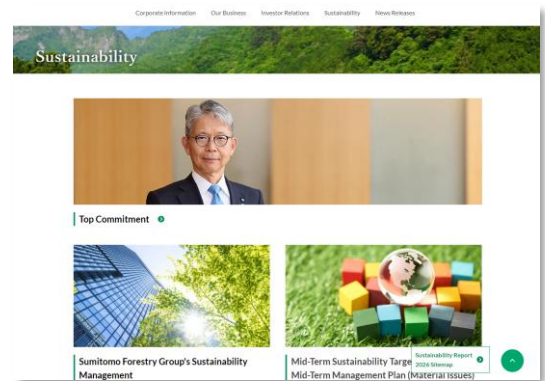
Aimed at investors and a wide range of stakeholders, this report provides a comprehensive overview of the Group's sustainability activities. It reports on our performance in 2025 against the numerical targets set for the nine material issues specified in our long-term vision Mission TREEING 2030, along with our sustainability initiatives integrated with our business operations.

It also describes our efforts toward achieving the targets set out in Mission TREEING 2030 Phase 2 (2025~2027), our medium-term management plan that began in 2025 under the theme, "three years of reform and implementation for dramatic growth." In the Mid-Term Sustainability Targets as part of the medium-term management plan, each business segment in our organization has formulated numerical targets with the goal to further integrate our business operations and ESG.

The Sustainability Report 2026 also includes information about our monitoring survey project, which includes forest biodiversity and water resource assessments, to create a foundation for establishing future targets and to quantitatively assess our contributions to nature positive. In addition, our ESG Data Book has been improved to provide a more organized compilation of Group-related data for better data viewability and convenience.

In the future, we will further enhance our disclosures related to climate change and other nature-related issues with updates about our nature-positive initiatives, the progress of our Transition Plan that we began formulating in 2025 to achieve carbon neutrality by 2050, and other efforts.
